

BRAND GUIDELINES

PRIMARY LOGO

The HookIn2Hockey logo is the primary brand mark that should be used across all generic Hockey Australia branded Hin2H collateral.

The logo is the visual expression of our brand, and as such should be valued and treated with importance. The following document shows how to use this branding, and should be followed in all instances.

To ensure legibility, there is a clear space guide around the logo as shown below. The space should always be clear of graphics, text and complex areas of photography.

The Hin2H logo should not be reproduced at a size smaller than 10mm wide. This is to preserve legibility in print formats.

The Hin2H primary alternates can be used in place of the main primary logo when necessary depending on the situation. Similar clear space and minimum sizing can be applied to these alternates.

COLOUR PALETTE

WEB & DIGITAL USE

PRINT USE

HOT TIPS FOR NAVIGATING YOUR BRAND FOLDER

- Search 'PNG' to bring up logo files with a transparent background, These are great for over top of images or coloured backgrounds.
- Looking for help or guidedance? Check out the 'Brand Guidelines' to find your colour palette, font links, guidelines and more!

The following files have been included in the branding folder. Here's a list of each individual format included for each variation of your logo, along with a brief explanation of how to use each file type:

PRINT FILE FORMATS



EPS is a print file format that supports vector data and is completely scalable. Use: when your designer or printer asks for version of your logo for print application/signage.



Used primarily for print, the PDF file is versatile and commonly used. Use for professional printing or easy email attachments. PDFs can be opened using the free version of Acrobat Reader as well as Adobe Illustrator. **Use: for printing purposes, or to send to print designers.**

DIGITAL FILE FORMATS



SVG is a web-friendly vector file format. As opposed to pixel-based raster files like PNGs, vector files like SVG can be significantly resized without losing any of their quality, which makes them ideal for logos and complex online graphics. Use: when your designer asks for 'vector' version of your logo to be used online or digitally.



A PNG is a web file that can have a transparent background and is generally larger and higher quality. Use: when you need to put your logo over a photo/background online.
